Notice is hereby given that the City of Santa Rosa (City) has prepared an EIR (State Clearinghouse No. 2023020166) for the proposed Santa Rosa General Plan 2050, also known as Santa Rosa Forward, (proposed project).

Project Description: The proposed Santa Rosa General Plan 2050 brings the current General Plan up to date with the latest State and federal legislation pertaining to urban development, transportation, climate resilience, and safety, and responds to local and regional housing needs, fosters economic growth and local job creation, enhances civic identity and placemaking, and protects sensitive natural resources. Zoning and/or land use changes supporting additional development capacity are proposed in select areas only. Changes to the city's transportation infrastructure propose new pedestrian and bicycle connections across Highways 101 and 12, road diets, and roadway widenings. The proposed Community-Wide Greenhouse Gas Reduction Strategy is an update to the City's 2012 Community-wide Climate Action Plan that identifies measures and programs to reduce greenhouse gas emissions generated by existing and future uses in Santa Rosa. Environmental Review: The Draft EIR includes an evaluation of potential impacts in the EIR Study Area (see attached map) and identified less-than-significant impacts for aesthetics, biological resources, cultural resources, energy, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, land use and planning, population and housing, public services, parks, and recreation, utilities and service systems, and tribal cultural resources. The Draft EIR identifies potential significant and unavoidable impacts at the program level in the topics of agricultural resources, air quality, noise, transportation, and wildfire. *The identification of these program-level impacts does not preclude the finding*

of less-than-significant impacts for subsequent individual projects that meet project-level thresholds of significance.

Submitting Comments: Members of the public, agencies, and interested organizations are invited to provide comments on the Draft EIR that focus on whether the Draft EIR is sufficient in discussing possible impacts to the physical environment, ways in which potential adverse effects may be avoided or minimized through mitigation measures, and alternatives to the project in light of the purpose of the EIR to provide useful and accurate information about such factors. A public meeting to accept verbal comments on the EIR will be held on **Thursday, November 14, 2024, at 4:30 p.m**.
