There are several actions that can be taken to improve housing and land use in Santa Rosa, California:


- 1. Promote the construction of affordable housing.

Existing Conditions

- 1. Housing cost.

Single and multi family developments, public educational buildings, office uses, roadways, creeks.

The area is divided into three subunits; West, Central and East.

Current housing and land use conditions in Santa Rosa, California have changed with the growth and diversification of the city, increasing housing demand and putting pressure on land. The city has faced challenges around affordable housing and the availability of land for development, but has worked to protect rural and agricultural areas near the city while encouraging development in already urbanized areas.

Case Studies

Small communities have taken advantage of small spaces of empty land and converting them to tiny house communities.

One of the most relevant studies is the General Plan of Santa Rosa 2040, which establishes a long-term vision for the development of the city. The plan focuses on promoting housing density and diversity, as well as the protection and sustainable use of natural resources. Some of the plan's specific recommendations include:

- 1. Encourage the development of affordable, high-density housing in existing built-up areas.
- 2. Improve access to public transportation and pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure.
- 3. Preserve and protect rural and agricultural areas near the city.
- 4. Encourage sustainable construction and land use practices.

In addition, a study by the Center for Climate Change and Global Health at the University of California, Los Angeles suggests that increased investment in public transportation infrastructure and the promotion of affordable and sustainable housing could improve the quality of life. residents and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Short Term Recommendations: Temporary RV Park

- RV shelter for homeless
- Inspired by Fairgrounds RV Park
- Only active in Summer months
- Housing Financial Assistance: Local government and nonprofit organizations may provide financial assistance to residents to help them pay their rent or mortgage. Particularly helpful for those struggling to keep up with housing costs due to lack of employment or reduced income due to the COVID-19 pandemic.





Tiny Homes
